The two effects sound great on their own and can also be combined to compliment one another. The compressor can sound like a vintage Dyna Comp or Ross compressor, but is much more versatile, having a Tone control (which can be turned on or off) and a clean-boost pre-amp controlled by the Gain knob. The overdrive channel is designed to improve on the sound of the TS-808 Tubescreamer, including a bass boost switch and far more output volume than the original.


